First, there are 2 three-week sessions of the registered daily program open to children ages 6-12: July 4-22 (Tuesdays to Saturdays) or July 25-August 12 (Tuesdays to Saturdays). Registration for the daily program begins Thursday June 1, 2017. Spots are limited, so stop by the front desk early to register!

Second, the library is opening up the Reading Challenge to all children and youths ages 6-17 in Taber. After every 5 books they read, readers registered with the Reading Challenge get the chance to win a pizza party - sponsored by Panago - hosted at the library. The Summer Reading Pizza Party Challenge begins Tuesday July 4, 2017 and the winner of the pizza party will be drawn Saturday August 26, 2017.
